

**OFFICIAL CALL
Mass Meeting
of the Staunton City Republican Committee
of the Republican Party of Virginia**

As Chairman of the Staunton City Republican Committee of the Republican Party of Virginia, and pursuant to the Plan of Organization, and as recommended and directed by the Committee, I, Matthew Fitzgerald, do hereby issue this call for a Mass Meeting to be held at the Staunton Public Library, 1 Churchville Ave, Staunton, VA 24401 on May 23rd, 2017 starting at 7:00 pm for the following purposes:

1. To nominate candidates for Constitutional Officers for the City of Staunton-Sheriff, Commonwealths Attorney, Treasurer, and Commissioner of the Revenue.
2. For the transaction of such other business as may properly come before the mass meeting.

Qualifications for Participation

All legal and qualified voters in the City of Staunton under the laws of the Commonwealth of Virginia, regardless of race, religion, national origin or sex, who are in accord with the principles of the Republican Party, and who, if requested, express in open meeting either orally or in writing as may be required their intent to support all of its nominees for public office in the ensuing election may participate as members of the Republican Party of Virginia in its mass meetings, party canvasses, conventions, or primaries encompassing their respective election districts.

Filing Requirements

Candidates for Constitutional Officers in the City of Staunton shall file a letter of intent to the Staunton Republican Committee containing the following:

1. Statement of intent to run for a specific Constitutional Office in the City of Staunton.
2. Affirmation that as of the date of the letter, and through the term of office, the signee is and will be a full time legal resident of the City of Staunton, Virginia.
3. Affirmation that the signee is in accordance with the principles of the Virginia Republican Creed.

The letter of intent shall be presented by mail or in person no later than 5:00 p.m. on Tuesday, March 28, 2017, to Louis March, Staunton Republican Committee Secretary at 1623 North Augusta Street, Staunton, VA 24401; postmarks do not govern.

Please note, if not more than 1 candidate meeting the qualifications noted in this call properly files a letter of intent by said date and time for Constitutional Officer in the City of Staunton, the candidate shall be considered elected and the mass meeting will be canceled.

There will be no nominations from the floor for Constitutional Officers for the City of Staunton.

Should a mass meeting occur, doors open for registration at 6:30 p.m. All qualified voters who wish to participate in the mass meeting must be in line by 6:59pm and have valid photo id.

Registration Fee

There is no registration fee to participate in the Mass Meeting.
